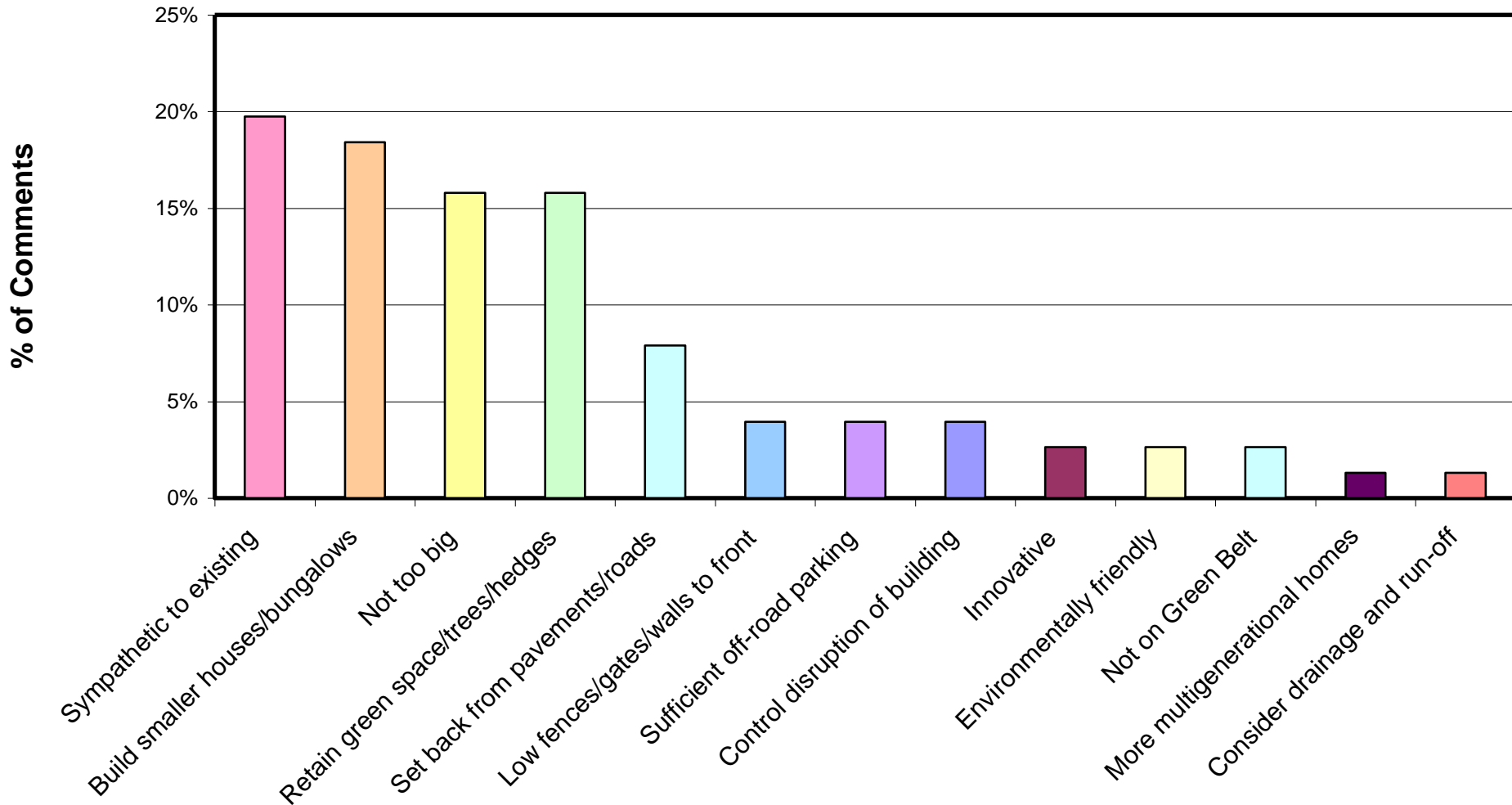
Attendees were asked to provide additional thoughts on development issues for the Parish. These are summarised graphically on the following charts under headings of:

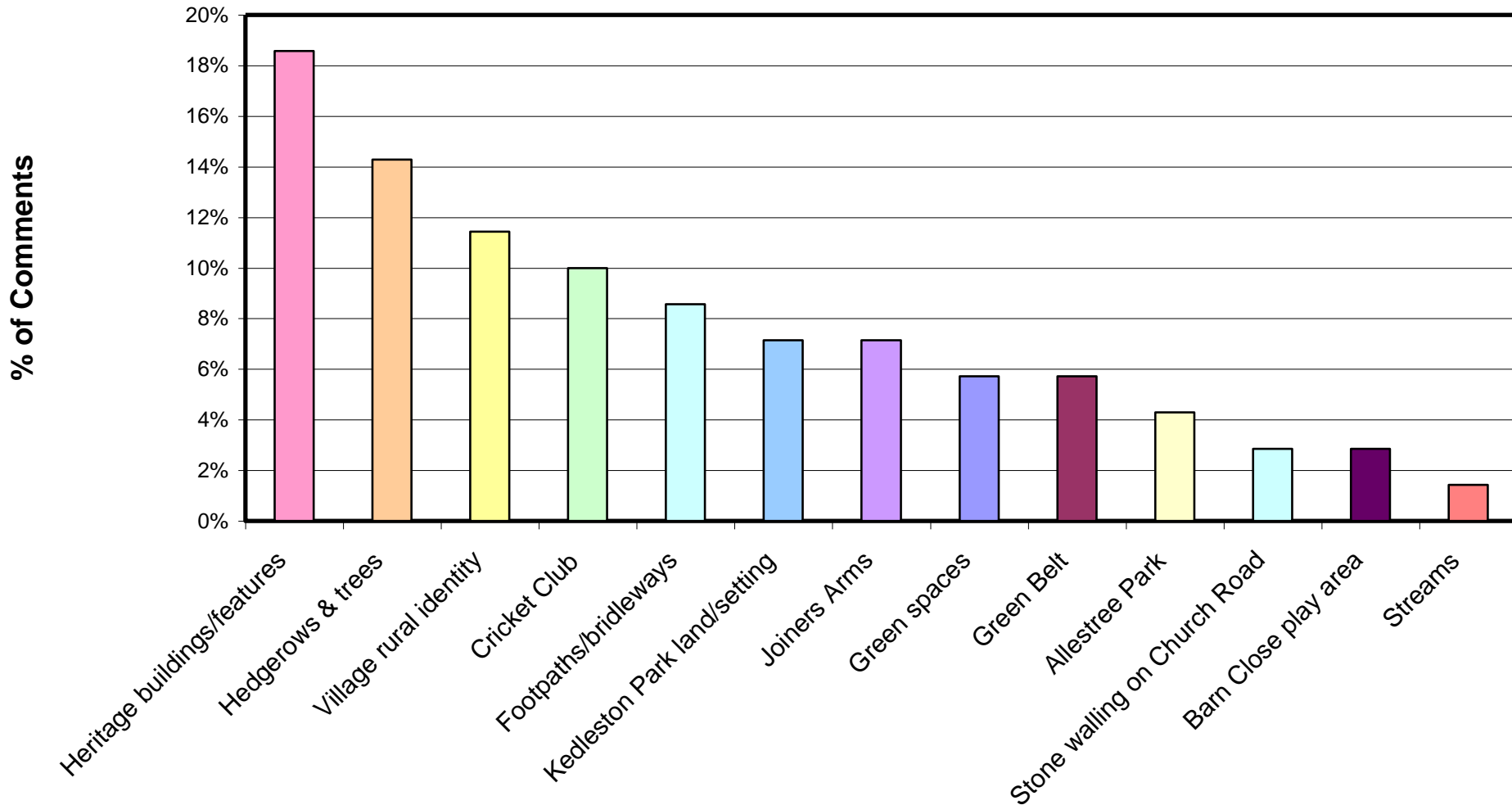
Views on housing development

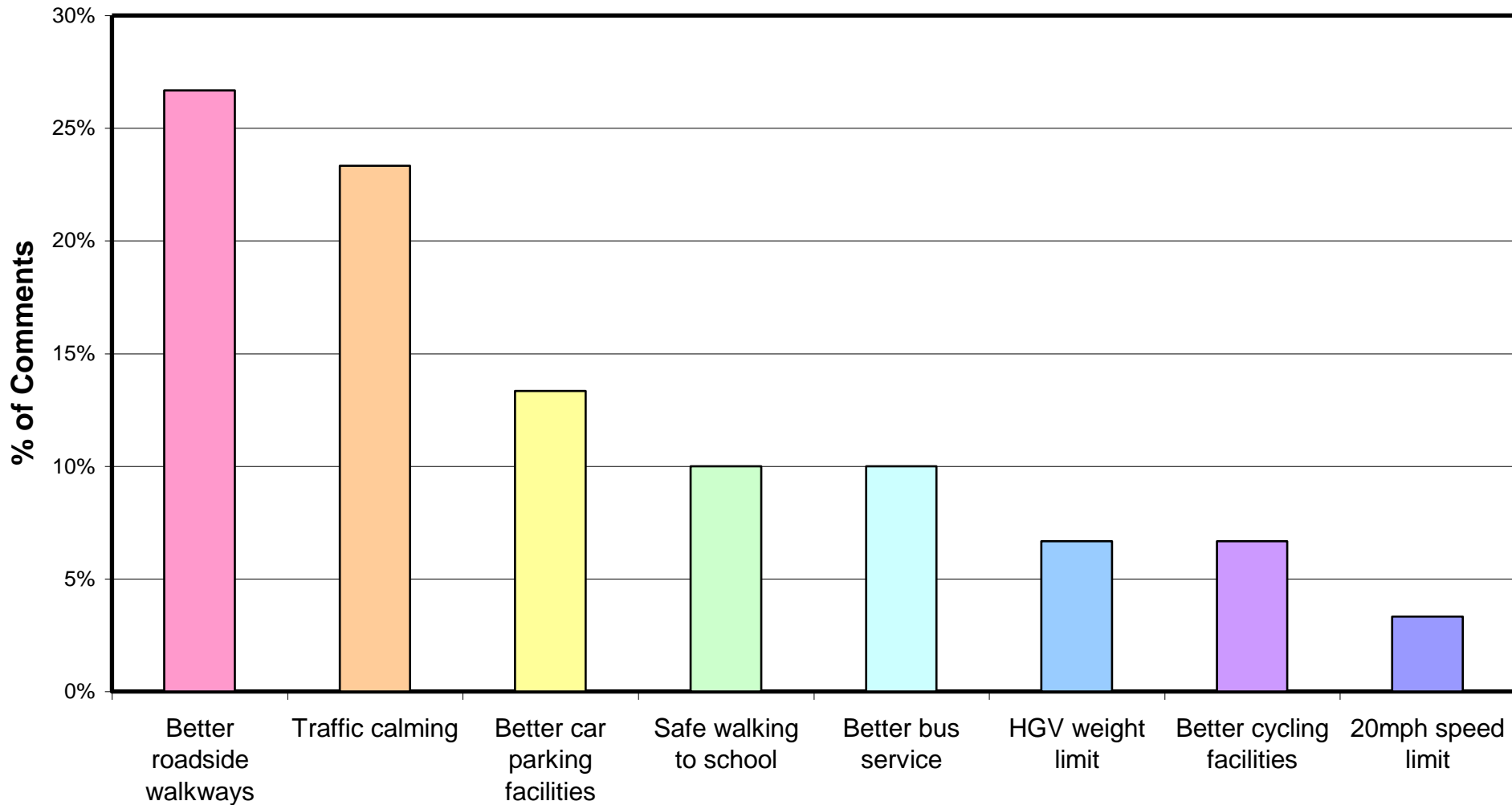
What should be preserved and encouraged in Quarndon

- Community/project fund to be set up to provide, say, £1,000 for each newly built bedroom beyond the second bedroom
- Upgrade Barn Close play area
- Encourage Kedleston estate to provide land for community orchard, allotments, coppice woodland
- Services for the proposed 400 Kedleston estate houses will be provided better by Allestree/Derby
- Need better broadband
- Include copy of NP in property purchase/sale documentation
- Need community work parties for village projects/charities
- Not convinced local shop will be useful for all parish, only people who live close by
- Encourage people to attend parish council meetings and comment on planning applications

- Look to provide land for allotments
- Please restrict access for the dog trainers from out of area (?)
